Mitropa Rally Cup starts 2021 season with record number of participants

- The Mitropa Rally Cup starts on 29 May with the Rally Velenje in Slovenia.
- In this probably strongest season opener for years, 44 Mitropa Rally Cup teams will start at this event.
- So far, 92 rally drivers and co-drivers from 6 nations have already registered for the Mitropa Rally Cup 2021.

(Munich, May 27, 2021) With a large participation of 44 teams of the Mitropa Rally Cup, the Rally Velenje will start on May 28-29. In addition to the predicate of the national championship of Slovenia, the rally is also the first competition for the Mitropa Rally Cup 2021. "The interest of our drivers in this rally is enormous, I can not remember that ever 44 teams were at the start of the season" says the president of the Mitropa Rally Cup Committee, Norberto Droandi.

The sporting decision will be made on 6 special stages over a total of almost 78 kilometers. The total length of the event is only 113 kilometers due to the pandemic restrictions. The compact rally, but known for its selective route, will start at 10 a.m. on Saturday, with the first competitors expected at the finish line from 4.30 p.m. onwards.

The Mitropa Rally Cup has so far registered 92 participants from Hungary, Germany, Austria, Italy, Slovenia and Croatia. Teams who also want to compete for points can still register online via the Mitropa Rally Cup website.

The Mitropa Rally Cup is of the oldest rally series in Europe. It was founded in 1965. Famous names such as Sandro Munari, Franz Wittmann, "Lucky" Luigi Battistolli, Armin Schwarz and Hermann Gassner have already entered their names in the series' winners' lists. Fans affectionately refer to the Mitropa Rally Cup as the "unofficial European Rally Championship for private drivers." The series is a championship recognized by the FIA (Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile). Participants can register in the categories FIA homologated vehicles and historic vehicles according to FIA Appendix K.
